The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
- The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School and Senior School Certificate Examinations and changes made therein from time to time.
- 3. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII:

14. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act -1995'.

15. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
